



Advanced safety systems to help handle unexpected conditions

Advanced safety systems are designed to help give you peace of mind every time you drive.⁺ Each one is engineered to help you maintain control, even in challenging road conditions and in some emergency situations. These safety systems are designed to function automatically, leaving you free to focus on the road ahead.

ELECTRONIC STABILITY CONTROL (ESC)

ESC monitors your vehicle's response during emergency maneuvers. It then controls the engine and brakes to help keep your Sportage on course.

TRACTION CONTROL SYSTEM (TCS)






